

## **NON-RESIDENTIAL TRASH AND RECYCLING SERVICES:**

### **Non-Residential Municipal Waste:**

Businesses are permitted to contract with their own hauler. Businesses, commercial establishments, industrial users, institutional centers and community events must report recycling figures to the Conewago Township. The recycling amounts for the reporting year of 2011 are to be submitted to the Township by January 15, 2012. Reports for completion are available on the Township website at [www.conewagotwpadamsco.us](http://www.conewagotwpadamsco.us).

### **Recycling:**

All commercial, institutional and municipal establishments within and community events held in Conewago Township are required to recycle in accordance with DEP's Act 101 and Conewago Township's Solid Waste Code/Chapter 125. These establishments and event coordinators are responsible for arranging for the collection and recycling of designated Act 101 materials. Conewago Township is required to submit annual recycling reports, including data from commercial, institutional and municipal establishments and community event to Adams County on or before February 15<sup>th</sup>. Adams County, as required by Act 101, submits an Annual Recycling Report each year for PA DEP record.

To satisfy PA DEP reporting requirements for these establishments and community events, Conewago Township will need to begin reporting commercial sector recycling data to the Adams County Recycling Coordinator on or before February 15<sup>th</sup>. **Therefore, it is imperative for non-residential establishments to provide recycling information on or before January 15<sup>th</sup>.**

Be advised it is your task to contract with a recycling service provider and report annually the types and amounts of materials recycled and the name of your contracted recycling service provider to Conewago Township.

Commercial establishments and community events located in Conewago Township are required to recycle the following materials:

- High-grade office paper
- Cardboard
- Metal Cans: all food and beverage containers made of aluminum, steel, tin or bi-metal (aluminum & steel).
- Leaf waste

Other recyclable materials are as follows:

- Plastic Containers: food and beverage containers made of PET and HDPE plastics. Other plastics (LDPE, PVC, PP & PS) are also recyclable, including soda bottles, milk jugs, water bottles, detergent bottles, and food containers.
- Other paper products such as old (clean) newsprint, magazines, and telephone directories.
- Glass Containers: food and beverage containers (bottles & jars) made of amber, clear and green glass.
- Appliances, textiles, mattresses, tires, wood packaging, automotive materials and substances, electronics, etc.

Check with your recycling contractor on how to prepare these items for collection.

You may acquire a recycling report, of which indicates the types of post-consumer recyclable materials necessary for recycling, at the Conewago Township Municipal Office or you may download a copy from the Township website at [www.conewagotwpadamsco.us](http://www.conewagotwpadamsco.us). Updates to this form will be available on the website. A copy of Act 101 will also be available on the website. It is your responsibility to ensure the report is completed each January and provided to Conewago Township by January 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.

### **Burning:**

Open burning is not permitted in Conewago Township.

### **Yard Waste Collections:**

You may contact H&H in Spring Grove at (717) 225-1479 for instructions on taking your yard waste to their facility in between the designated Township yard waste collection dates.
